FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

It was almost 10 years ago. I recall the excitement with each new woman I visited, and the anticipation of a new future that ensued. One woman at a time; one life at a time, each new woman representing what turned out to be the Lord's original leaders for this ministry of love and healing. This year we have reached a new plateau.

Funding from Substance Abuse Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) has provided an opportunity to grow and mature. As we seek even higher levels of performance, we are striving to become a model program for sister ministries across the country. We desire to be gentle servants and good stewards, loving and blessing each new woman as Jesus would have done.

WHATS NEW?

- The WHM family has grown substantially in the area of partnerships and ministry this year. Thanks to the Federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration Grant we kicked off our Face to Face Mentoring Program in January. The funding has allowed WHM to hire 7 new employees, as well as expanding our services by opening a new office in El Cajon.
- Exciting news! This year we have been able to welcome 78 new women to the WHM family, by offering comprehensive services and mentoring. Many were directly referred to us by the Sheriff's Department at the Vista and Las Colinas Detention facilities.
- Recently the Lord opened the doors to the California Institute for Women, a state prison in Corona and Puerta la Cruz Conservation Camp.

The response has been incredible and to date several women have been gathered up by a WHM woman upon release with many more to come.

- Our mentoring training has equipped 27 precious volunteers, committed to mentoring a woman for one year. These selfless women come to us from churches in North, South and East Counties. They will continue the loving support that is the foundation of WHM offering wrap around care and supportive services to women in the process of restoration.
- WHM staff has been invited to be on the panel for a workshop at the National Conference for Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration in Washington D.C. to share on "What Makes Quality Service for Women?"
